**HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2008**

Regulations made by the Governor in Council under section 75 of the Elections Act, R.S.A. c. E30.

**Amendment of section 1****1.** Section 1 of the House of Assembly Elections Regulations, R.R.A. E30-2, is amended—

(a) by replacing subsection (1) with the following—

“(1) Subject to subsections (1A), (5) and (6), the Supervisor of Elections shall be paid at the rate of \$500 per month.” ;

(b) by adding the following after subsection (1)—

“(1A) Where there is an election, the Supervisor of Elections shall be paid—

(a) in relation to a general election, an amount arrived at when the following formula is applied—

$$A = 3 \times (PS \div 12)$$

where—

A = amount payable

PS = annual salary at the lowest step of a Permanent Secretary in the employment of the Government of Anguilla as shown in the Annual Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure as approved by the House of Assembly; or

(b) in relation to a by-election, an amount arrived at when the following formula is applied—

$$A = PS \div 12$$

where—

A = amount payable

PS = annual salary at the lowest step of a Permanent Secretary in the employment of the Government of Anguilla as shown in the Annual Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure as approved by the House of Assembly.

(1B) An amount referred to in subsection (1A) becomes payable on the day the Writ of Election is returned to the Governor.” ;

(c) by replacing subsection (2) with the following—

“(2) The following rates, or amounts, as the case may be, shall be paid to the officers hereinafter mentioned for their services in connection with the registration of voters or the holding of any election, as the case may be—

(a)	in the enumeration year, a Registration Officer .....	\$1,500.00 per month
(b)	an enumerator for an electoral district with—	
	(i) 600 or less registered voters .....	\$4,000.00
	(ii) more than 600 registered voters but less than 1000 registered voters .....	\$5,000.00
	(iii) 1000 or more registered voters .....	\$6,000.00
(c)	a Returning Officer of an electoral district where the election was contested .....	\$1,125.00
(d)	a Returning Officer of an electoral district where the election was uncontested .....	\$ 565.00
(e)	a Presiding Officer .....	\$1,050.00
(f)	a Poll Clerk .....	\$ 600.00
(g)	a Tally Clerk .....	\$ 150.00
(h)	a Typist for the typing of each name appearing on the official list of voters .....	\$ 1.25 per name” ; and

(d) by adding the following after subsection (3)—

“(4) If any amount is payable under this section to a person who is appointed to a public office other than one referred to in this section, that amount shall be payable as an allowance.

(5) In the enumeration year, the Supervisor of Elections shall be paid at the rate of \$5,000 per month, which shall be payable from one month before the start of the enumeration period referred to in section 4 of the Election Registration Regulations, R.R.A. E30-1, until 2 months after the date on which the register is proclaimed to be in force.

(6) For the one-year period beginning 1 January 2009, the Supervisor of Elections shall be paid at the rate of \$2,000 per month.

(7) For greater certainty—

(a) in any month when an amount referred to in subsection (1A) is payable, that amount shall be paid instead of the rate referred to in subsection (1); and

(b) when a rate referred to in subsection (5) or (6) is payable, that rate shall be paid instead of the rate referred to in subsection (1).”.
