

Revised Regulations of Anguilla: E30-2

ELECTIONS ACT (R.S.A. c. E30)

HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS REGULATIONS

Note: These Regulations are enabled under section 75 of the Elections Act, R.S.A. c. E30.¹

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Remuneration of officers

- 1. (1) The Supervisor of Elections shall be paid—
 - (a) at the rate of \$600 per month from the date when the Governor instructs him to prepare for the holding of any election until a date 2 months after the return of the Writ of Election to the Governor; and
 - (b) \$240 in each enumeration year and \$120 in any other year when a list of persons qualified to vote is prepared.

(2) The following amounts shall be paid to the officers hereinafter mentioned for their services in connection with the registration of voters or the holding of any election, as the case may be—

- (a) the Registration Officer (as Registration Officer for all electoral districts) \$1,000.00
- (b) an enumerator for an electoral district with—
 - (i) 600 or less registered voters \$1,500.00
 - (ii) more than 600 registered voters but less than 1000 registered voters \$2,000.00
 - (iii) 1000 or more registered voters \$2,400.00

(c) a Returning Officer of an electoral district where the election was contested	\$750.00
(d) a Returning Officer of an electoral district where the election was uncontested	\$375.00
(e) a Presiding Officer	\$700.00
(f) a Poll Clerk	\$400.00
(g) a Typist for the typing of each name appearing on the official list of voters	\$.75

(3) For exceptional reasons shown the Governor may authorise a variation of the above rates in any particular case.

Travelling

2. For travelling in connection with an election or the registration of voters, officers shall be paid at the rate that is payable by way of travelling allowance to public officers.

Statement of candidature

3. (1) The expression “political party” hereinafter appearing means any party, members of which contest an election.

(2) Where candidates from the same political party contest an election the secretary of the party shall file with the Supervisor of Elections a certified joint statement made by such candidates according to the form prescribed in Schedule 1.

Symbols for ballot paper

4. There shall be printed upon every ballot paper opposite the name of every candidate who has been allocated a symbol the appropriate symbol, being one of the symbols shown in Schedule 2.

Party symbol

5. The same symbol may be allotted to every candidate from the same political party, if so requested by that political party.

Allotment of symbols

6. Allotment of symbols shall be at the discretion of the Supervisor of Elections, but so far as possible he shall allot to each political party or individual candidate the symbol requested.

Citation

7. These Regulations may be cited as the House of Assembly Elections Regulations, Revised Regulations of Anguilla E30-2.


