**A LAW TO AMEND THE ELECTIONS LAW (2009 REVISION) TO
INCREASE THE SPECIFIED NUMBER OF ELECTED MEMBERS OF
THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND
CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Elections (Amendment) Law, 2012.

Short title and
commencement

(2) This Law shall come into force upon the next dissolution of the Legislative Assembly.

2. The Elections Law (2009 Revision) is amended in section 5(2) as follows -

Amendment of section 5
of the Elections Law
(2009 Revision) -
electoral districts and
representatives

(a) by repealing paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph -

“(b) George Town Electoral District - six elected members;” and

(b) by repealing paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraph -

“(d) Bodden Town Electoral District - four elected members;”.
