Fellow Grenadians, Carriacouians & Petite Martiniquians,
Good Evening.

In this broadcast I wish to address the following information
to the candidates:-

1. As you are aware, Nomination Day is on the 18th June 2008. You are expected to deposit the following to the Returning Officer of the Constituency of which you are seeking election to represent in the House of Representatives:-

- (a) Your nomination paper which must contain the names of six registered electors of the Constituency for which you are seeking to be elected. You are also expected to fill into that form your acceptance of that nomination by the six registered voters. This form must be signed by you in the presence of a witness who will also sign it.

- (b) A statutory declaration of your qualifications to be elected which must be made and subscribed to before a Justice of the Peace or any other such person. Of course, this declaration can be made on your behalf by someone acting as your agent, if in the event you are absent from the State.

- (c) The sum of three hundred dollars (\$300) in cash [not cheque]. Failure to do this, your nomination shall be deemed to be void.

Please take note that the above must be delivered to the Returning Officer at his/her office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on the day set aside as nomination day.

The relevant forms for doing so can be obtained from the office of the Returning Officer at his/her Constituency Office.

Here, once again, are the locations of the offices of the Returning Officers of the Constituencies:-

- (i) Town of St. George, Gore Street, Upstairs Myrna Wilson's Building.
- (ii) St. George North East, Deco's Building Complex, Mt. Gay.
- (iii) St. George North West, Beausejour Community Centre.
- (iv) St. George South, Belmont Close to Lexus Inn.
- (v) St. George South East, Marian Community Centre.
- (vi) St. David, Downstairs PWD Building, Petite Esperance.
- (vii) St. Andrew South East, In the Agriculture Office, Seaton James Street, Grenville.
- (viii) St. Andrew South West, Grand Bras next to the Community Centre.
- (ix) St. Andrew North East, Belair Government School.
- (x) St. Andrew North West, Annex to Mr. Mitchell's Shop Mirabeau.

- (xi) St. Patrick East, IDC Building, Sauteurs.
- (xii) St. Patrick West, IDC Building.
- (xiii) St. Mark, Upstairs the Old Market, Victoria.
- (xiv) St. John, Public Works Building, Gouyave.
- (xv) Carriacou & Petite Martinique, Main Street, Hillsborough, Upstairs the building next to Republic Bank.

2. You should identify the persons you are appointing as your agents at the various Polling Stations, and to ensure that they have their appointment letters and the forms on which they take their oath. They are to present these to the Presiding Officer on polling day to certify that they are duly appointed by you. The letters of appointment and oath of the agent chosen by you to witness the final count must reach the Returning Officer at least one clear day before the poll begins. That is by Monday 7th July 2008. Both the appointment and oath forms are available at the office of the Returning Officer.

Please note also that transfer certificates are prepared for those of you who may require them for voting purposes.

I wish to give you now the number of polling stations in your Constituency which should assist in the selection of your agents:-

- (iii) St. George North West
- (iv) St. George South
- (v) St. George South East
- (vi) St. David
- (vii) St. Andrew South East

- (xiv) St. John
- (xv) Carriacou & Petite Martinique
